NIU's College of Business offers six undergraduate programs in Accountancy, Business Administration, Finance, Management, Marketing, and Operations & Information Management. **To enroll in FINA 320, MGMT 335, MKTG 310, a student must complete a Transcript Review Form in Undergraduate Advising & Student Resources, Barsema Hall 201, and have completed the following criteria:**

- A minimum of 45 earned credits
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 (Transfer & NIU Hours)*
- A grade of C or better in the 100- and 200-level business core listed below
